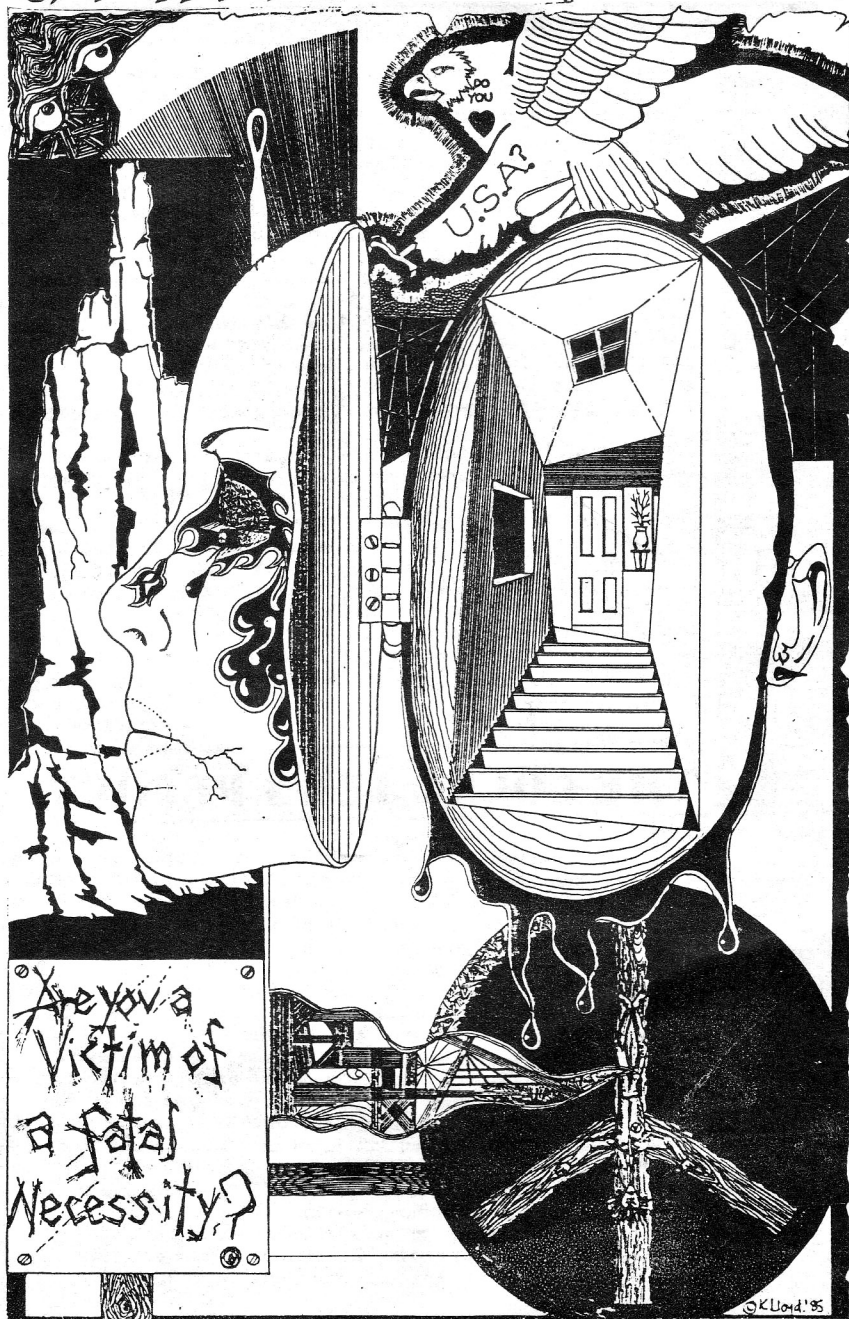

As you can tell from the brevity of this report not a great deal has been going on music wise over the past few months. We've had one benefit gig organised by the local anarchist group, which saw the emergence of a new band - BAND WITH NO NAME (no..really) who show some promise - hopefully more on these in future editions. THE SWAPPING BOGSEATS managed to squeeze onto a tour with Toxic Toys and Avoid, which should be coming off this September. Also touring will be BLIND AMONGST THE FLOWERS who've had an offer to go to Chicago, I think a record is in the offing for them as well. THE ORANGE PEEL, a newly established duet using a clever mixture of backing tapes and drum machines also came out of the garage and recorded their first tape which is now available for 80p, worth a listen if you're into wierd punky stuff. PANIC GRASS the local noise boys and patrons of the Stride lable have changed their name to THE BOYS FROM BRAZIL so that they can wear funny shirts.

PICTURE FRAME SEDUCTION

Picture Frame Seduction formed in 1979, the founder member being Keith. They soon picked up a following and by 1982 were voted the best band in Wales. At the end of '83 the old guitarist and Bassist left which meant that the band was able to progress and create a more individual sound. As the new Picture Frame Seduction they have done loads of gigs and are about to start a tour to promote their new album "Hand Of The Rider" which will be released by Rot Records on September 27th.

Anyway, a new bassist and guitarist were soon found and they complete the present line up today - Mark/guitar, Griff/drums, Keith/vocals, Steve/bass. In June '84 they did a very badly promoted British tour when they played alongside bands such as the Subs, Exploited, Alien Sex Fiend, Urban Dogs, and The Fits.

What sort of music do they play? I hear you say, well it's very fast tuneless hardcore/thrash metal sort of stuff with a difference, it says here on their info. sheet that it "...thrusts from the pit of your stomach and doesn't let go."

For those of you interested in their politics, they say that they are a socialist sort of band but don't want to be compared with the Russian style of Communism, more along the lines of our own Labour party - maybe a bit more towards the left. THEY say that "At least with with the one thing we are allowed to do -(vote)- we can speak our minds in a democratic country."

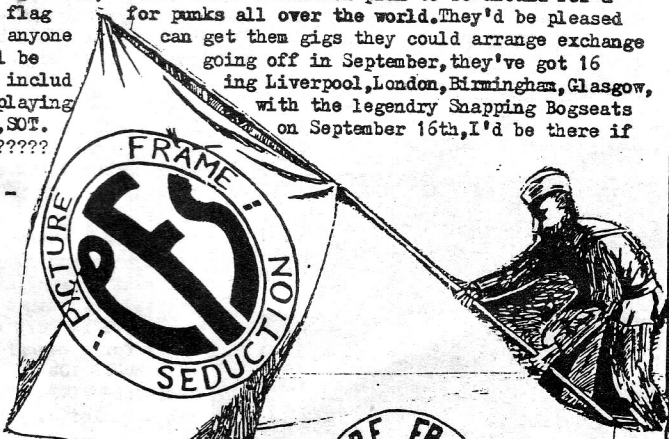
They say that musically their music doesn't compare to any other, apart maybe to early GBH, the way they like it and the way, they assure me, that it's going to stay. Good, fast and political, "what the punters like". They are all concerned about international animal abuse, I therefore presume that they are actively involved in preventing it, demos, flyposting etc.

Not that it matters but Keith is 21, Griff is 23, Steve is 17 and Mark is 19. Influences are GBH, the energy of the Exploited, Picture Frame Seduction plan to be around for a few years yet carrying the flag for punks all over the world. OI POLLOI

Oi Polloi are an Edinburgh based band who specialise in a brand of music that's pretty unique. The fact that they play Oi when they are punks is unusual enough, combine that with some mighty fine chant along anarchist lyrics and you're getting somewhere near to what Oi Polloi are about.

I haven't got much background on the band but I do know that they've been going some time and started life as The Four Herberts. They've got a couple of tracks on the 'Rot In Hell' compilation entitled "Never Give In" and "Thugs In Uniform". They've also got a couple of demo's out which you can get for £1-00 & S.A.E. from - 5 Royal Crescent, Edinburgh. EH3 6PZ. They should be doing a new one sometime this September, so watch out for it. To get a bit more information I sent 'em an interview which they sent back within a week, cheers lads!

Before we start I should just point out that the questions have been answered by all the band, Deek, Guv and Rab.

WHAT DO YOU SEE AS THE MAIN DIFFERENCE (IF ANY) BETWEEN PUNK AND SKIN MUSIC ?

Guv - Skinhead bands are a lot more musical most of the time. Punk bands tend to be a lot more aggressive, and faster.

Rab - It's just different brands of music.

DO YOU AGREE WITH PEOPLE LIKE BUSHELL WHO SAY THAT OI SHOULD BE A FURLEY WORKING - CLASS MOVEMENT ?

Guv - I don't see how the amount of money you've got changes anything - so long as your mum and dad aren't lords and ladies!

Rab - Anybody can do it.

DO YOU GET MUCH OF A CHANCE TO PLAY IN EDINBURGH, IS THERE MUCH OF AN INTEREST IN PUNK THERE ?

Rab - It's not bad - but it could be better.

Guv - There's not enough real punks and skins in Edinburgh - too many poofs!

WILL YOU BE PLANNING A RECORD OF YOUR OWN IN THE NEAR FUTURE ?

Deek - I don't think we're well enough known to do a record on our own yet - we're just sticking to tracks on compilations for the present.

APART FROM BEING IN A BAND, WHAT ELSE DO YOU LOT GET UP TO ?

We fight the system from dawn to dusk!
WHAT DO YOU THINK IS THE MAIN UNDERLYING MESSAGE TO YOUR SONGS, WHAT ARE YOU TRYING TO ACHIEVE ?

Deek - In a nutshell I suppose the underlying message in our songs is "open your eyes, see what's wrong and then get up of your backside and fight to make the world a better place". We're just trying to do our bit to fight for a peaceful co-existence.

WHAT WOULD YOU SAY WERE YOUR INFLUENCES MUSICALLY/MENTALLY, IF ANY ?

Rab - Exploited musically and Conflict mentally.

Guv - Exploited.

Deek - Musically and lyrically I like Anti-Sect, Icons of Filth, Discharge and early Flux. Mental influences are too many and too varied to mention.

CAN YOU SEE YOURSELVES STILL LISTENING/PLAYING THE SAME STYLE OF MUSIC IN THREE YEARS TIME ?

Once again, we here at Open Sore bring you a scoop, in the shape of a damn fine band from right on my doorstep - The Neighborhood Brats. If you haven't already got to see them, they've mainly only played local gigs in Crewe - I can tell you that live they're one of the most exciting, powerful and humorous bands I've seen. I suppose that their music brings back a bit of nostalgia 'cos amongst their cover versions they do an excellent version of the old Stooges classic, "Wanna Be Your Dog". Mind you that's not to say that they haven't got any songs of their own, they have and they're as original as the early punk was in 77. Anyway I got hold of the drummer, Al, and got him to write a bit for the zine, and so -

We formed in the Summer of '82 as 'The Evicted', there were many line up changes but nothing ever happened. Our first gig was in February '84, we were shit, but enjoyed it. Since then we've been improving slowly, the present line up is - Rad-vocals/Mike-guitar/Johnny Brat-bass/Al Eruption-drums.

We have no political stance, we have not got a message for the youth of today, and we don't want to enforce our views onto other people. We just write songs for fun, or

songs that mean something to us. There are too many bands around that lecture you on anarchy, animal rights or whatever, it just bores me. Your average punter is aware of what's going on around him, he doesn't need it rammed down his throat all the time.

Our idea of a good gig is having a few drinks, listening (dancing if you feel like it) to some good live music, and above all enjoying yourself.

We're intending to play lots of gigs this year and also record some sort of a demo (we only have poor quality live recordings at the moment or practice tapes). To exchange gigs/info/tapes write to - Alan Evans

finnish scene report

FINLAND ???! It's a cold place with lots of bogs, forests and lakes. Wild polar bears running in the streets of Helsinki (...well, that's a joke...there's no polar bears in Finland, as everybody knows ???). It's very close to Russia, and is the ONLY European country phisically bordering Russia. Here lives under 5 million lunatics who go wild about sport and alcohol (lots of mad alcoholics who hide in bushes). Its language is totally outside the sphere of other European countrys, the nearest being Hungarian. Socialism is not strong in Finland, contrary to popular belief....it's really wierd innit ???

Punk first began to ruin the youth of Finland with bands like PELLE MILJONNA & NUS (the very first), SEMSUURI, KOLLAA KESTAA, WIDOWS, VANDAALIT, RATSIA and BRIARD (ex band of Andy McCoy/Hanoi Rocks). These bands have now either split up, or worse, started to play pop and comercial stuff like that. The new rise of Finnish punk started when Propaganda Record. started releasing punk records. Now there's lots of new punk lables like Barra bbas and Rat Poison, as well as lots of self produced ones.

Right then, the bands. There's not a great deal going on in the capital, Helsinki, the most popular there, is VARAUS (Charge) who have a very individual sound. They did a split LP called "Tagasaki '84", and an excellent E.P. "Tuomittu Elamaan" (Doomed To Live). They also have tracks on Propagandas LPs, "Hardcore '84" and "Finnish spunk/Heartbeat". The word is that VARUS has recently split, let's hope it's not true. You can get in touch by writing to - Timppa Vuorenmaa/Siltakuja 13/04400 Jarvenpaa.

MASSACRE formed in the late spring of '83 under the name Sotatila. They did lots of gigs including a local battle of the bands style gig, which was shit. They made a few line up changes and soon were progressing towards the forefront of the Finnish punk scene. In late February '84 they did their first demo which was released as a single, selling

about 700 copies, which is pretty good for Finland. They released another single which is still available for £2-00. An album is now in the pipeline (might already be out) on the Propaganda lable. If you want more information tapes, etc, write to - Tuho records, c/o Pete Vaisanen/34320 Parkku/Finland.

MELLAKKA formed in April '83 'cos there was no punk bands where they lived, Rauma. They've had more line up changes than anyone can remember and say that they are influenced most by bands like Discharge. They've just done a really powerfull EP which contains 7 anti-army songs, called "Ei". Although this EP has nearly sold out another is supposed to be on the way. Ch, by the way, the name MELLAKKA means Riot.



From Kouvola comes MAHO NEITSYT (Barren Virgin). They've done a single "Mita On Punk ?" (What Is Punk ?) and the latest release is the EP "Tehdaskaupungin Lapset" (Children of Manufacturing Town). "Slightly slower than the usual Finnish stuff, but don't let that put you off." (review from Huddersfield Sucks zine) They also have plans for an album. If you want more information then write to - Peri/Box 10/45141 Kouvola 14. From Vilppula comes one of Finland's most celebrated hardcore bands, RATTUS. (which comes from the Strangers album "Rattus Norvegicus".) They did one or two rather uninteresting singles in their early days, but their new stuff is just...it's just....RATTUS. The "Rajoitettu Ydinota" (Limited Nuclear War) EP sold well all over the world, as did their LP "WC Rajahtaa" (WC Explodes), mini LP "Uskonto On Vaara" (Religion Is Danger) and a new LP "Rattus" which will be released by Rat Cage records (c/o 70 Greenwich Ave, 112, N.Y. 1001, USA). The singer of RATTUS is also involved with another great band, PAZUZU, to get more information on either band write to - Rattus/Box 69/40101/Jyvaskyla 10/Finland.

Oh yeah,gigs.The gig situation is a bit better these days,but still not as good as the early days,partly because the bands are rawer than then,so it's more of a cult thing than the old rock 'n roll style punk of the 70s.It's also due a lot to some of the 'punks' who behave like dick-heads and think that it's fun to wreck venues and fight with the police/each other(so what's new ?).Anyway the punk scene in Finland is thriving,I reckon that the only way you're gonna be able to find out more about the bands/records is to write to people in Finland 'cos only a small percentage of stuff gets across the water.Here's a few addresses that you might find of use - Record Companies:



O.K. You've heard of the Stupids, well here's THE interview. Not much of an introduction I know but who gives a shit? On with the interview.....

WHAT INFLUENCES THE LYRICS TO YOUR SONGS?

Lots of things, some are quite ordinary, for example songs like "Who Do You Think You Are", "This Is The Norm.", they are attacks on everyday happenings, but songs like "Elephant Man" come from quite strange sources. We were touched by the film so we wrote a song about it.

WOULD YOU SAY THAT YOU HAVE A MESSAGE TO CONVEY THROUGH YOUR MUSIC?

Yes, FUN!!!! That doesn't mean jumping around sticking your tongue out or pulling stupid faces when there's a camera about. We try to be as humorous as we can with our music.

We have a few meaningful songs which punks would call a mess. Just 'cos they don't say "Fuck" they have no meaning.

TELL US ALL HOW YOU GOT TO P

I sent a tape once to Dig on send me a good thrash tape in return. As a result of this he got us a show in Notting ham and he liked us so much he asked us to go on his flexi so we did.

WHAT DO YOU THINK IT IS THAT MAKES THE STUPIDS SUCCESSFUL 'COS THERE'S A LOT OF THRASH BANDS KNOCKIN' ABOUT AT THE MOMENT?

I don't know, I'm not really in a position to say without being big headed. I suppose we're pretty different which could have a lot to do with it.

WHAT ARE YOUR BELIEFS AS A BAND/PERSONALLY?

Mainly to have fun and enjoy life as much as possible without hurting other people. I suppose you could say we have the same views as any average punk band but we don't like to go into deep stuff like politics, inside the band.

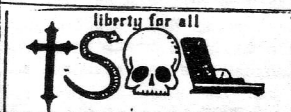
WHAT DO YOU PERSONALLY THINK OF RELIGION?

Personally I have nothing against it. It starts to stink with all this every Sunday with the family shit. If it's done sincerely and people believe in it and have fun then it's pretty cool. People say preaching in the towns is brainwashing BALLS !!! You're not made to listen, they're only trying to persuade you and in most cases are actually

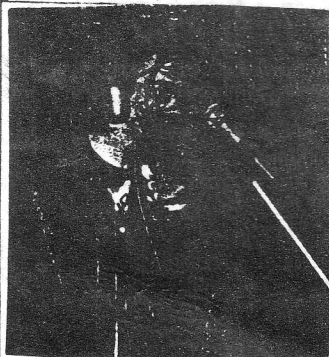
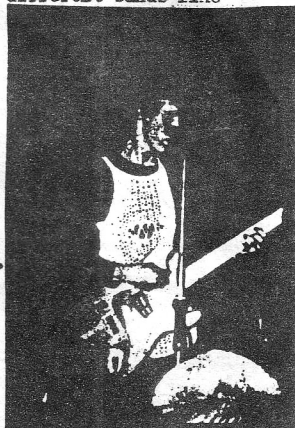


SUB HUMANS

Right then, who wants to know all the boring facts, c'mon, hands up. Oh, well I'm gonna tell you anyway. The original members started life in many different bands like The Mental, Audio Torture and the Stupid Humans. In 1980 all these bands split and by August the original line-up of Dick, Bruce, Andy and Grant were doing local gigs. In early '81 the Demolition War demo tape was recorded which was turned down by everyone. In June '81 Andy left to join the Aheads and was replaced by a very young Trotsky on drums. He was 15 then so by my calculations he's 19 now. Around June Flux offered to put out a single on the new Spider-leg label. The Mob and Flux then helped out loads with gigs and soon they were on the way to "foam cushions and enormous phone bills."

Grant left in October '83 and was replaced quickly by Phil. Since then they have toured in Holland, Ireland, America, England and Sweden. They say that they are still broke but prefer being so rather than charge rip-off prices at gigs and make promoters and agents rich.

Before anyone asks, no Trotsky is not a Hippie, yes they are all vegetarians and no, they don't live in squats.



Y'know, as general background info. goes, that wasn't at all bad, was it?

I also sent Dick an interview so -

"WHO'S GONNA FIGHT" AND "WORK REST PLAY DIE" GIVE THE IMPRESSION THAT YOU ARE IN FAVOUR OF A VIOLENT WORKING-CLASS STRUGGLE, IS THIS SO?

Not really, for a start violence breeds violence and should only be used when all else fails - using phrases like "kick until it breaks" is provoking people to think a bit more in terms of action and results rather than thinking that 'being rebellious' is enough. As for class struggle, there are only two classes of people, oppressors and oppressed, and as most of the oppressed don't realise that they are oppressed (and therefore unwillingly support the oppressors) what we need is a mass realisation of this structure in order for it to be changed, and talking about change is not going to get that, unless it comes with poss

itive action.

HOW DID THE AMERICAN TOUR GO, DID THEY LIKE YOU?

It went pretty good, a lot of people had never seen or heard us before but the general reaction seemed to be good - hardly any violence either. There's a lack of political awareness over there in general, but activists do exist, just in smaller numbers than over here. (%) Animal liberation is catching on really well, particularly on the West Coast.

WHY EXACTLY DID GRANT LEAVE THE BAND?

He disagreed with the idea of being political in our lyrics and he didn't see the band progressing as he'd like it to.

WHAT DO YOU THINK HAS BEEN YOUR BEST GIG SO FAR?

Impossible to say 'cos we've done so many and we couldn't all agree on one anyway! The Liberation gig in London and one on the Shetlands come to mind, but a good gig is nearly always down to the atmosphere and the people there, rather than playing good.

THE 'CRADLE TO THE GRAVE' L.P. IS REALLY DEPRESSING, IS THERE NOTHING THAT YOU LIKE ABOUT TODAY'S SOCIETY?

It's only depressing if you think that's all there is, and don't like any of it, and can't escape the routineness of it all. (so actually it is depressing for most of us) I don't like the way people are treated like objects by the system (teachers, police and armed forces, all basically employed by the government) and individuality is controlled by social restrictions of law and upbringing and history. Natural things cheer me up like the sea 'cos it's uncontrolled. I'm either depressive or too paranoid "for my own good" (ha ha).

DOESN'T BEING A PUNK BAND ALIENATE YOU FROM PEOPLE WHO MIGHT BE OTHERWISE SYMPATHETIC TO YOUR VIEWS?

Probably, but that's mostly down peoples narrow minded thinking, "all punks are obscene and violent 'cos the Sun says so", etc. We want to reach as many people as possible so isn't just routine thrash and our words apply to nearly anyone with a conscience. WHAT'S ALL THIS BUISNESS WITH THE FISH ALL ABOUT?

I like fish! (but not to eat) and they don't have wars and things, so I figure they're more sensible than we are.

HAVE YOU EVER EXPERIENCED ANY TROUBLE AT ANY OF YOUR GIGS?

Very little actually. I think that if bands sing about violence and act like macho men then they attract violence, but we don't so we don't.

WHAT ABOUT NEW RECORDS, WHAT RELEASES HAVE YOU GOT PLANNED BOTH YOURSELVES AND FOR ANY OTHER BAND?

Not much 'cos records keep failing to sell enough to break even. Our third L.P. "Worlds Apart" in September and an Iconclasts (U.S.)/Instigators split L.P. later on in the year, a co-release between Blurg and Rusmort

(Rusheads lable) and a compilation L.P. (one day). ANYTHING TO SAY?

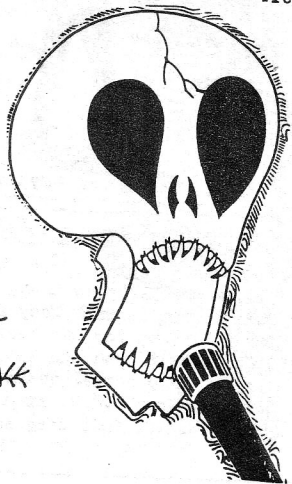
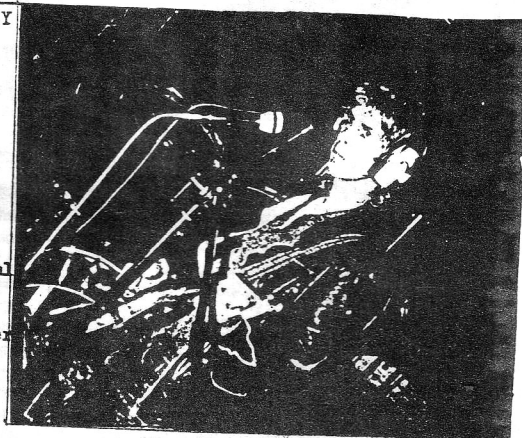
Too much.

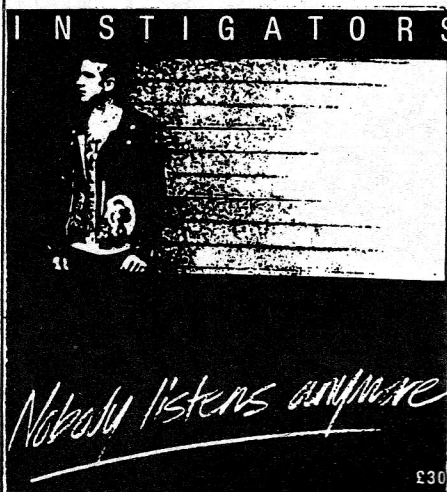

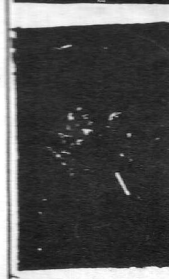

ARE YOU PLANNING ANY RECORDS?

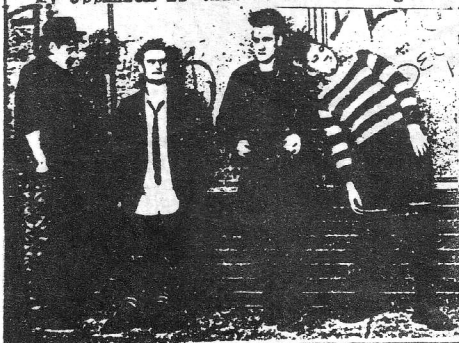
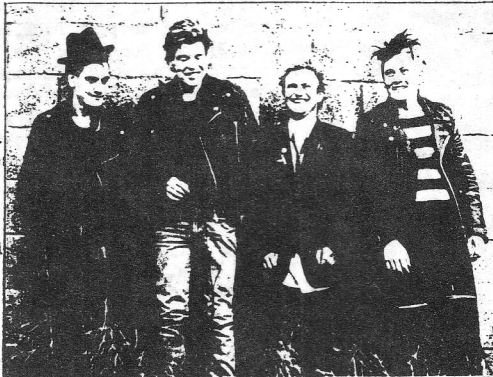

A.O.C.A.

A.O.C.A. (All Out Attack) formed in the late summer of '82, basically because there was nothing else to do but also to get their feelings across to more people, they felt that music was the best way of achieving this. '82, they say, was the time to react against and fight for their individualism.

Their individualism shows up in their songs because they don't necessarily agree with the same issues as other bands but share the fight for the right to live their lives in peace.

At present A.O.C.A. consists of - Bruce/bass, Steve/lead vocals, Deek/drums, Scott/guitar & backing vocals. A.O.C.A. originally stood for All Out Attack, but after a while they got pissed off with that name but kept the initials. Now it could stand for a lot of things such as - Authority Organises Armageddon, Anarchy Or Apathy or anything really.

They're not too into people who are out to label them as a particular type of music, punk, anarchist etc. They do however admit to having 'Punk roots' and indeed do fight for anarchy and peace but see the music press as the people who capitalise on this just to cause friction and confrontation between different musical styles.

They believe in disarmament of all weapons including so-called conventional weapons. Conventional or not, they say that all weapons are becoming so sophisticated and powerful that soon they would be as powerful as nuclear weapons, as is stated in their song 'Germ Warfare'. All weapons cause pain and death but people either won't accept or else are ignorant to this fact.

All of the band are vegetarians and believe that the use of animals for human necessities and needs is wrong and causes a lot of useless suffering. All of the band try not to use any animal products whatsoever, this includes eating animals which they say is just "pure fucking cannibalism".

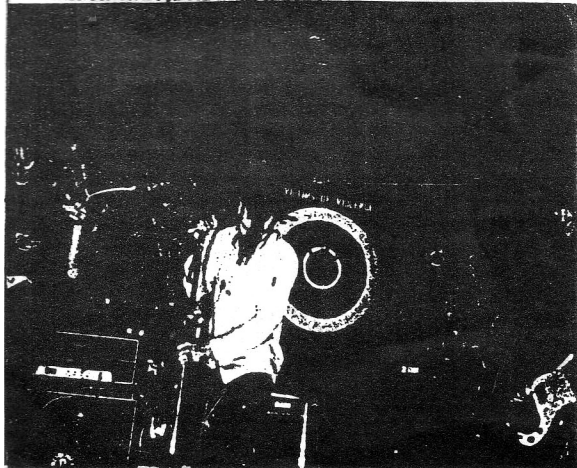
They also hold strong views about sexism. "Women are equal to men - everybody's fucking equal. We don't care much for this macho big-man bullshit, that men are the masters and women are just their slaves. People are fed the shit all the time, perpetuated by T.V. newspapers and porno-filth, we think, are, a serious incentive to cause rape and to cause a distorted picture of what women are.

Finally, they have recorded a 12" single, released by C.O.R. Records, entitled 'Who Are They Trying To Con'. They plan to do as many gigs as possible. 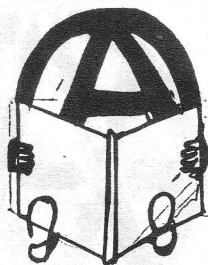

On October 31st 1984 the Police And Criminal Evidence Act 1984 became law, but the bulk of it's new powers were not available to the police until Autumn 1985 - now.

*Power to STOP AND SEARCH you in the street or any other places and search any vehicle in which you are travelling on reasonable suspicion that you posses an offensive weapon, equipment for stealing or stolen goods. You can also be stopped on suspicion that you posses controlled drugs under drugs legislation.

A police officer who is not in uniform must first produce some identification that he/she is a police officer, but only an officer in uniform can stop a vehicle. BEFORE a search is carried out you should be told -

- 1) the officers name and station to which he/she is attached,
- 2) the purpose of the search and the reason for making it, and
- 3) that you are entitled to a copy of the record of the search that should be made, but only if you ask for one - so ask at the time.

You should only be searched by an officer of the same sex and it should take no longer than a minute. You may be required to take of certain clothing but if this consists of more than an outer coat, jacket or gloves, it must not be done in public.

*Power to establish a ROAD BLOCK for an unlimited period and stop any vehicle to see if it is carrying a person who has committed, is intending to commit or is 'witness' to a serious arrestable offence, or an escaped prisoner.

*Power to ARREST YOU FOR ANY OFFENCE no matter how trivial it is, if you fail to give your name and address to the police, or if they don't believe the one you give.

*Power to DETAIN YOU WITHOUT CONTACT WITH THE OUTSIDE WORLD for up to 36 hours from the moment that you arrive at the police station and on the say so of the police alone. This period can be extended to a total of 4 days by warrants issued by a magistrates court sitting in closed session.

*Power to STRIP SEARCH you in the police station.

*Power to subject you to an INTIMATE BODY SEARCH of body orifices such as the mouth, anus and vagina where the police suspect that you are hiding a weapon that could be used to cause injury.

This search can be carried out by a police officer of the same sex as you and not necessarily by a medically qualified person. If the police suspect you of hiding a Class A drug (heroin, cocaine and LSD for example) and of dealing in drugs you can be searched in the same way but only by a doctor or registered nurse at a hospital or doctors surgery.

*Power to SEARCH YOUR HOME even though you are not suspected of any offence.

The police must identify themselves and a copy of the warrant issued by the magistrates court authorising the search must be given to you. The search must take place within 1 month from the date the warrant was issued and it authorises one search only. However once inside your home the police can seize anything which they believe is evidence of or was obtained in consequence of the commission of any offence.

As you can see this act represents a massive extension of the coercive power of the police. This is only a summary of the main points. tape reviews

AD-NAUSIEM - FIVE SO MAD.

Now this is what I call a fucking racket !!! Stop The Van opens and I can assure you that it's really wild. Screaming vocals, heavily distorted guitar and thumping bass lines give this tape reall power.
