FROM SECTION 33 TO 36, TOWNSHIP 7 NORTH, RANGE 23 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN

MONUMENT DESCRIPTIONS:

FOUND A 2½ INCH STAINLESS STEEL PIPE WITH A ¾ BRASS CAP STAMPED AS SHOWN, ENCIRCLED BY A MOUND OF STONES, 3.0 FEET IN DIAMETER AND 10 INCHES ABOVE THE GROUND. FOUND THE MONUMENT IN FAIR CONDITION, LEANING SLIGHTLY. STRAIGHTENED THE MONUMENT AND REBUILT MOUND OF STONES. SET A U CHANNEL ALUMINUM POST WITH A FOREST SERVICE 54-9 MONUMENT SIGN, 1.5 FEET SOUTHERLY. FOUND 1986 BEARING TREES:
BT1: A 24 INCH JUNIPER, S16°W, 51.6 FEET
BT2: A DEAD AND FALLEN ASPEN (RECORD WAS S48.5°E, 48.2 FEET)
BT3: A 10 INCH JUNIPER, N33°W, 54.4 FEET
BT4: AN 18 INCH JUNIPER, N42°E, 179.7 FEET
ADDED, TO EACH LIVE TREE, A FOREST SERVICE 54-3 BEARING TREE SIGN AND A 6" MAG SPIKE AND "PLS 7172" STAINLESS STEEL WASHER FOR A CHAINING POINT AT CENTER RIGHT SIDE. NO NEW BEARING TREES ESTABLISHED

FOUND A 2½ INCH STAINLESS STEEL PIPE WITH A ¾ BRASS CAP STAMPED AS SHOWN, ENCIRCLED BY A MOUND OF STONES, 5.0 FEET IN DIAMETER AND 14 INCHES ABOVE THE GROUND. FOUND THE MONUMENT IN EXCELLENT CONDITION, STRAIGHT AND SOLID, REBUILT MOUND OF STONES. SET A U CHANNEL ALUMINUM POST WITH A FOREST SERVICE 54-9 MONUMENT SIGN, 3.0 FEET SOUTHERLY. NO NEW BEARING TREES ESTABLISHED

SET A STANDARD US FOREST SERVICE ALUMINUM MONUMENT WITH A ¾ INCH DIAMETER ALUMINUM CAP, STAMPED AS SHOWN, ON A 2½ INCH DIAMETER POST, 30 INCHES LONG, 24 INCHES IN THE GROUND, ENCIRCLED BY A MOUND OF STONES, 3.0 FEET IN DIAMETER AND 6 INCHES ABOVE THE GROUND. PLACED A PLASTIC ENCASED MAGNET BENEATH THE MONUMENT. SET A U CHANNEL ALUMINUM POST WITH FOREST SERVICE 54-9 MONUMENT SIGN AND A FOREST SERVICE 54-2 BOUNDARY SIGN, 2.5 FEET SOUTHWESTERLY. NO NEW BEARING TREES ESTABLISHED

SET A STANDARD US FOREST SERVICE ALUMINUM MONUMENT WITH A ¾ INCH DIAMETER ALUMINUM CAP, STAMPED AS SHOWN, ON A 2½ INCH DIAMETER POST, 30 INCHES LONG, 24 INCHES IN THE GROUND, ENCIRCLED BY A MOUND OF STONES, 3.0 FEET IN DIAMETER AND 6 INCHES ABOVE THE GROUND. PLACED A PLASTIC ENCASED MAGNET BENEATH THE MONUMENT. SET A U CHANNEL ALUMINUM POST WITH FOREST SERVICE 54-9 MONUMENT SIGN AND A FOREST SERVICE 54-2 BOUNDARY SIGN, 2.5 FEET SOUTHWESTERLY. NO NEW BEARING TREES ESTABLISHED

FOUND A 2½ INCH STAINLESS STEEL PIPE WITH A ¾ BRASS CAP STAMPED AS SHOWN, ENCIRCLED BY A CRUMBLING MOUND OF STONES. FOUND THE MONUMENT IN FAIR CONDITION, LEANING SLIGHTLY, STRAIGHTENED THE MONUMENT AND REBUILT MOUND OF STONES TO 3.5 FEET IN DIAMETER AND 14 INCHES ABOVE THE GROUND. SET A U CHANNEL ALUMINUM POST WITH A FOREST SERVICE 54-9 MONUMENT SIGN AND A FOREST SERVICE 54-2 BOUNDARY SIGN, 3.0 FEET NORTHERLY. NO NEW BEARING TREES ESTABLISHED

FOUND A 2 INCH IRON PIPE WITH A ¾ BRASS GLO CAP STAMPED AS SHOWN, ENCIRCLED BY A CRUMBLING MOUND OF STONES. FOUND THE MONUMENT IN FAIR CONDITION, LEANING SLIGHTLY, STRAIGHTENED THE MONUMENT AND REBUILT MOUND OF STONES TO 4.0 FEET IN DIAMETER AND 20 INCHES ABOVE THE GROUND. SET A U CHANNEL ALUMINUM POST WITH A FOREST SERVICE 54-9 MONUMENT SIGN, 3.0 FEET SOUTHERLY. FOUND 1987 BEARING TREES:
BT1: A 6 INCH ASPEN, N80°E, 38.1 FEET
BT2: A 10 INCH ASPEN, S45°W, 57.2 FEET
BT3: AN 8 INCH ASPEN, S43°E, 171.2 FEET
ADDED, TO EACH TREE, A FOREST SERVICE 54-3 BEARING TREE SIGN AND A 6" MAG SPIKE AND "PLS 7172" STAINLESS STEEL WASHER FOR A CHAINING POINT AT CENTER RIGHT SIDE. NO NEW BEARING TREES ESTABLISHED

FOUND A 2½ INCH STAINLESS STEEL PIPE WITH A ¾ BRASS CAP STAMPED AS SHOWN, ENCIRCLED BY A MOUND OF STONES, 4.0 FEET IN DIAMETER AND 6 INCHES ABOVE THE GROUND. FOUND THE MONUMENT IN FAIR CONDITION, LEANING SLIGHTLY, STRAIGHTENED THE MONUMENT AND REBUILT MOUND OF STONES. SET A U CHANNEL ALUMINUM POST WITH A FOREST SERVICE 54-9 MONUMENT SIGN AND A FOREST SERVICE 54-2 BOUNDARY SIGN, 2.0 FEET SOUTHEASTERLY. FOUND 1986 BEARING TREE:

FOUND A 2½ INCH STAINLESS STEEL PIPE WITH A ¾ BRASS CAP STAMPED AS SHOWN, ENCIRCLED BY A MOUND OF STONES, 6.0 FEET IN DIAMETER AND 30 INCHES ABOVE THE GROUND. FOUND THE MONUMENT IN EXCELLENT CONDITION, STRAIGHT AND SOLID, RE-BUILT MOUND OF STONES. SET A U CHANNEL ALUMINUM POST WITH A FOREST SERVICE 54-9 MONUMENT SIGN AND A FOREST SERVICE 54-2 BOUNDARY SIGN, 3.0 FEET NORTHEASTERLY. NO NEW BEARING TREES ESTABLISHED
